## **Thermal Imaging Surveys**

Since the end of October 2023 Greening Glemsford are proud to have hosted a Flir Edge camera on behalf of Suffolk Climate Change Partnership. The camera, which uses thermal imaging to identify heat loss from homes, will have been borrowed by 10 other Parish Councils by the time the project ends on 8th April 2024. Also, members of Greening Glemsford have been busy using our own Parish Council Flir One Pro camera to survey buildings in Glemsford, including the village hall. Before warmer weather arrives we hope to carry out one last survey at Glemsford Primary Academy, where the Eco School Committee are looking into how much energy the school is using this year compared with last year.
